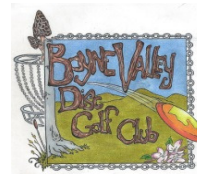


BOYNE VALLEY DISC GOLF CLUB



Meeting Minutes from Tuesday 6/2/15

- Attendance: Forrest Omland, Jonathan Winslow, Bill Fuller, and Rob Wiltjer. 2015 schedule: first Tuesday of every other month. 2/3, 4/7, 6/2, 8/4, 10/6, 12/1. Meeting minutes from 4/7 and 5/5 were not available for review but were approved. Correspondence was received from Nicolette Blakeslee (Boyne Valley Garden Club). She provided some nice information regarding native plants in case we decided to "spruce up" our tee pad areas with flowers or bushes in the future at Avalanche.
- Membership report: ended 2014 with 76 members. We started fresh in 2015 and are up to 79 members as of 6/2/15.
- Treasurer's report: club funds and ace pool were not discussed at the meeting. Note: Forrest Omland was once again elected to be treasurer on 5/5/15.
- Secretary's report: we will add this at the meeting.
- Course status report: everything is in great shape following the 5/30 tournament.
- League director's report: added Pat Hood to the league committee on 5/5/15.
- Club bag tags: ordered & received. Same style as 2014. Thanks again to Justin Mosley.
- Club challenge tags: still waiting for someone to draft challenge tag rules (Rob Wiltjer). Until then "tags are always live" is the only unwritten rule we seem to be following.
- Club officer positions: on 5/5/15 we held a special officers meeting and finally voted on several positions. These are available in the 5/5/15 meeting minutes and will be posted on our website and Disc Golf Scene.
- Avalanche course rating: was #99 in Michigan on Disc Golf Scene at start of 2013. Now "A-" rating, #35 in Michigan with 81 reviews. Keep asking everyone to leave a course review. Every comment helps. Status on DG Course Review = 3.09 out of 5 with 23 reviews. Need to work on improving that soon.
- Boyne City Parks & Recreation Commission meetings: Forrest was the only member in attendance in May. Asking for more members to attend on 6/4/15 where we will ask for permission to install one cement tee pad, and then with positive feedback and approval we will do approximately 9 of the 18 holes with cement hopefully.
- Old Avalanche baskets: waiting for Andy Kovolski to post them available for bidding. Forrest will check with him regularly and help collect individual bids for a group bid. Unfortunately he is so busy that Andy probably won't get to it anytime soon.
- Club charter: the first draft is finally complete and is available on the website. ☺

- Club website: domain has been renewed through 4/17/17 (about \$16 per year) so we are good for a while. Forrest will continue to be the webmaster for now and will regularly make site updates and improvements. Note: our club is now listed on several other websites including the Boyne Area Chamber of Commerce.
- Club PO box: opened on 11/18/14, \$32 for 6-months, paid \$64 for a year. Our new club address = PO Box 712, Boyne City, MI 49712-0712. Renew in November 2015.
- Tournament leaderboard scorecard holder: Forrest will plan to buy the one from Innova for \$99 if there are no objections.
- Club shirts: everyone look into this more and we'll talk about it at the next meeting. Look at dri-fit and other similar types. Forrest will try and send out a questionnaire. Recommendations include Threadsy Tees and Logo Pros.
- Club tools: tamper and post hole digger have been purchased. Buy more as needed.
- Club checking account: need to open one soon, possibly at Bay Winds (new 4Front). We have our EIN and our 4 officers defined. Now we just need to open the account.
- Tee signs: all 18 are finally done and installed! Thanks to everyone who helped.
- East Jordan Tournament on 5/16/15 and Avalanche Tournament on 5/30/15: They were a great success. Thanks to everyone who helped out!
- Boyne Valley Trilogy Challenge on Sunday 7/12/15: Tournament director = Jason McCary. Start having meetings to get ready for it soon. Encourage everyone to register and pre-pay if possible so we can order players packs.
- 3rd Annual Haunted Hyzer on Saturday 10/10/15: Spread the word and encourage everyone to register on Disc Golf Scene.
- Draft a tee pad improvement proposal: we will present at the 6/4/15 city meeting.
- Joining the PDGA Affiliate Club Program: on 2/4/15 we decided to try out the PDGA Affiliate Club program and paid \$25 for one year. Use code 15BVDGCAFF in 2015 to get \$5 off each membership plus several other discounts. See how many people end up using the discount code and decide whether to renew in 2016.
- Adding Disc Baron as new club sponsor in 2015: when it comes to buying discs and other supplies, we always advocate supporting our local businesses like Tom & Dick's in Petoskey and Tilley's in Traverse City. If you're in Grand Rapids or shopping online, check out Disc Baron dot com. Our friend and club member Jacob Stahl has a cool disc golf retail and online store, and he'll be a club and league sponsor this year.
- Concrete paver tee pad trial on hole #2: well it survived the winter and actually looks as good as new. Our somewhat rushed installation process left the pavers more slippery than the test pad we were able to throw from, so Forrest plans to try some

tennis court paint to see if that does the trick. The 4x8 layout of 24" pavers is 2 shorter than we planned since some vandals broke two of them, but it looks really cool and the majority of the feedback has been positive. All 8 large concrete pavers stayed really level. Forrest proposes trying one more pad using a 3x7 layout of 18" pavers, possibly on hole #13.

- Club patches: putting this on hold for a while unless someone can help with them.
- Club logo: keeping the same club logo for 2015.
- Meeting adjourned at 7:30pm. Next club meeting = Tuesday 8/4/15 at 6:00pm.
