

BVDGC Bag Tag Challenge

Rules

The Boyne Valley Disc Golf Club (BVDGC) is excited to bring you the 2016 Bag Tag Challenge rules and guidelines to have a fun safe round. Tags are a fun way to show other clubs how you shoot amongst your home club, or a great way to add a new twist to a casual round, a league night, or a tournament. Please respect our rules as we have put a lot of effort into making this easy and fun for all players.

1. This is a fun and friendly competition
2. Higher number tag challenges the low number tag (example: tag13 challenges tag11)
3. Challenged player must give the challenger at least 3 opportunities to defend the tag, if the challenged player refuses, he/she forfeits the tag. If challenger cannot make any of the dates, challenge is void.
4. Challenged player picks the course, tees and format of play.
5. All challenges must be accepted (result in possible loss of tag if becomes a problem)
6. All leagues and tournaments where there are at least 2 tag holders is considered a Bag Tag Challenge! (example: if 2 or more tag players are playing in worlds, it's a challenge)
7. Everyone is responsible for helping the tags run smoothly this year.
8. The lowest tag number is the tag keeper per round/tournament.
